MONDAY-WEDNESDAY-FRIDAY WATERING SCHEDULE

Suggested watering schedule for Monday-Wednesday-Friday watering, **ONLY IF REQUIRED!**

1. Per the watering instructions on the LawnSaver bag, we recommend watering **DAILY**. If, due to a drought, or when watering Monday-Wednesday-Friday is **REQUIRED**, please follow the following watering schedule. However, **ONLY FOLLOW THIS SCHEDULE IF MONDAY-WEDNESDAY-FRIDAY WATERING IS REQUIRED!** Daily watering is much more effective with LawnSaver, but this modified schedule for Monday-Wednesday-Friday watering will also work just fine.

2. Set your sprinkler watering clock as follows:

a. We still need 7 watering cycles per week. In order to water Monday, Wednesday and Friday only, we are going to need to add an additional watering cycle at 12:00 AM Sunday morning, so that we have a total of 7 watering cycles, which should not be a problem. We will be watering each Monday, Wednesday and Friday at 12:00 AM and 6:00 PM. It's a tricky way to still water every night, but water Monday, Wednesday and Friday, with an additional watering Sunday at 12:00 AM (unseen).

b. Here is how you will still be watering every night, even though you are watering twice per day on Monday, Wednesday and Friday (which is OK with cities with these watering restrictions) plus early Sunday AM: **Monday night** watering at 6:00 PM. **Tuesday night** watering Wednesday morning at 12:00 AM. **Wednesday night** watering at 6:00 PM. **Thursday night** watering Friday morning at 12:00 AM. **Friday night** watering at 6:00 PM. **Saturday night** watering Sunday morning at 12:00 AM. **Sunday night** watering Monday morning at 12:00 AM

c. Set PROGRAM A to start watering at 12:00 AM on Monday, Wednesday, Friday and SUNDAY. Then set PROGRAM B to start watering at 6:00 PM on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

d. Set watering **RUN TIMES per the instructions on the LawnSaver bag**, with same run times for both PROGRAM A and PROGRAM B. Even though you will be watering smaller amounts twice every other day, this will still give your lawn time to dry out inbetween two watering cycles.

e. The following is a calendar example to help you see how your lawn should be watered using the above settings:
